Admission

Admission to the programme is open to students holding a diploma or an equivalent degree (MA, Dipl.-Rest.) in conservation-restoration. English proficiency is required as the study programme is taught in English. The admission procedure consists of two phases: the submission of a written application and a personal interview held in English.


